

Thursday

Thank you Lord that because of Jesus I can forgive the people who hurt me today

It's so hard when you've been badly hurt by people,
but when you focus on it
it affects you negatively.

Jesus said the answer is to forgive.

Forgive even if you don't feel like it – just decide to do it.

Even as Christ forgave you, so you also do. (Colossians 3:13)

Jesus has forgiven you everything you've ever done wrong, are doing wrong and will do wrong. And He's made it possible for you to forgive others.

If you start thinking about your hurts – stop.
Forgive again.
Turn your thoughts to Jesus.
Thank God that He has forgiven you.

I Can Today Because of Jesus

Monday

Thank you Lord that because of Jesus I can live today without thinking negative thoughts about myself

God looks on you as His beloved child. Decide to think of yourself that way today.

If you start to think negatively about yourself – stop.

Jesus has forgiven you all your sins
and He loves you just the way you are.

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus.
(Romans 8:1)

Turn your thoughts to Jesus.
Thank Him for His forgiveness
and bask in His unconditional love.

Tuesday

Thank you Lord that because of Jesus
I can do everything You want me to do today

God loves you so much.

With Him everything is possible –
nothing is impossible

I can do all things through Christ, who strengthens me. (Philippians 4:13)

Decide to believe Jesus and take Him at His Word. Choose to do things today that you know please Him. Just go ahead and do them.

If you start to worry that you can't – stop.

Turn your thoughts to Jesus.

Thank Him that you can do them all with His strength.

I Can Today Because of Jesus

Wednesday

Thank you Lord that because of Jesus I can resist the devil today and he will flee

God wants you to be free from all the negative stuff the devil would throw at you.

And Jesus has made it possible.

Because He defeated the devil on the Cross you have the authority to tell him to go in the name of Jesus.

Be subject therefore to God.

Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

(James 4:7)
