PRAISE THE LORD MY SOUL!

Let me make you think – how often do you praise God outside of church? I'm not asking you that to condemn you, but just to make you think honestly. Sometimes we don't praise God because we just don't think of it or maybe we don't feel like it. The title of this booklet is taken from the first words of Psalm 103. The psalmist commands himself to praise the Lord. It's got nothing to do with how he feels or what's going on – he tells himself to just do it. We need to do the same and praise God regardless of our circumstances or how we feel. Psalm 35:9 says – '*My soul shall be joyful in the LORD. It shall rejoice in his salvation.*'

Hebrews 13:15 tells us to – '*offer up a sacrifice of praise to God continually.*' It might be a sacrifice of our time or our effort or it might be a sacrifice of our own thoughts and feelings – an acknowledgement that God's way is perfect, not ours and that He knows the answers better than we do. Decide to make that sacrifice and praise Him no matter what, and you will find blessing which far outweighs the sacrifice. We can set time aside to praise Him, but we can also praise Him through the day as we go about our lives. Nothing and no-one can stop us from praising God. So let's command ourselves to praise the Lord and obey.

Why Should We Praise God?

Praising the Lord is something we should simply do because He is God and worthy of it all. Psalm 29:2 says – '*Ascribe to the LORD the glory due to his name.*' And Psalm 92:1-2 tells us that – '*It is a good thing to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praises to your name, Most High, ² to proclaim your loving kindness in the morning, and your faithfulness every night.*' So let's do it. As Psalm 147:1 says, let's – '*Praise the LORD, for it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant and fitting to praise him.*' (147:1)

What Difference Will It Make?

There are so many blessings which are available to us when we are born-again and truly praise the Lord. However, they will not come to people who simply sing or say the words as a duty or in a rote fashion. God knows our hearts and so He knows who is sincerely praising Him and who is simply going through the motions.

However, be aware that if you are praising God in order for these blessings to come into your life, then you are not praising God – you have another agenda. But when you truly praise Him with your focus totally on Him and not on yourself or what you want from Him, then these blessings are indeed yours. Psalm 5:11-12 says – *‘But let all those who take refuge in you rejoice. Let them always shout for joy, because you defend them. Let them also who love your name be joyful in you. ¹²For you will bless the righteous. LORD, you will surround him with favour as with a shield.’* Let’s look at some of these wonderful blessings.

The presence of God

The Bible tells us that God lives in the praise of His people. Psalm 22:3 says – *‘you are holy, you who inhabit the praises of Israel.’* As born-again Christians, God lives within each one of us and will never leave us. But when we truly praise Him, He also lives in our praises and we can feel His presence in a tangible way.

The answer to despair

Praise takes our focus off our problems and onto God. It can then lift us up out of despair. Isaiah 61:3 says God has provided – *‘the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness,’* Put the garment of praise on. It will dispel despair and depression if you will allow it to.

When we praise Him He lifts us up

What a wonderful blessing – when we lift God up in praise, He lifts us up. Psalm 89:15-16 says – *‘Blessed are the people who learn to acclaim you. They walk in the light of your presence, LORD. ¹⁶In your name they rejoice all day. In your righteousness, they are exalted.’*

³ Give thanks to the Lord of lords,
for his loving kindness endures forever;
⁴ to him who alone does great wonders,
for his loving kindness endures forever; (136:1-4)

I will give you thanks with my whole heart.
Before the gods, I will sing praises to you.
² I will bow down towards your holy temple,
and give thanks to your Name
for your loving kindness and for your truth;
for you have exalted your Name
and your Word above all. (138:1-2)

I will give thanks to you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made.
Your works are wonderful. My soul knows that very well. (139:14)

The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tents of the righteous.

Praise silences the devil

Psalm 8:2 says – '*From the lips of babes and infants you have established strength, because of your adversaries, that you might silence the enemy and the avenger.*' Jesus quoted this in Matthew 21:16 but He said 'Praise' instead of 'Strength'. So praise is strength – strong enough to silence the devil and all his lies.

Praise will stop fear

When you start to feel fearful, make a decision to praise God there and then, like the psalmist in Psalm 56:3-4 – '*When I am afraid, I will put my trust in you. ⁴ In God, I praise his word. In God, I put my trust. I will not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?*'

So How Do You Praise Him?

You can praise Him with words alone or sing His praises. Praise really needs to be out loud – there is huge power in the spoken or sung word. But that doesn't mean that you can't praise Him in your thoughts when it's not possible to voice it. But get into the habit of praising God out loud whenever you can. Praise Him for who He is and for what He's done – for all that Jesus has done and won for you, for all His blessings, for all His promises in His Word, for His love, His faithfulness and His goodness, for His presence inside you, for His gifts and so much more.

The rest of this booklet contains 120 passages from Psalms which you can use to praise Him. All the verses I have chosen relate to us as born-again Christians living after Jesus died and rose again. Every promise of God was fulfilled in Jesus and so can be ours today – it's all about Him, not us. Think about that as you praise Him. Use the passages as God leads you. You could take one a day and keep it in your heart, speaking it out through the day. You could take a page a day or two or three. You could set a good length of time aside and go through all of them. There are no rules. They are here to help you to praise the Lord and see His majesty and glory, His love, goodness and faithfulness more and more as you do.

The passages are in the order they appear in Psalms. Some focus on God and who He is, His power and His majesty. Others focus on what He has done for us and on His love. Some are a means of encouraging ourselves to praise Him. Let all these verses inspire you to your own words of praise. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you as you praise the Lord and you will bring delight to the heart of God.

But you, LORD, are a shield around me,
my glory, and the one who lifts up my head. (3:3)

I will give thanks to the LORD according to his righteousness,
and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High. (7:17)

LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!
You have set your glory above the heavens! (8:1)

I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart.
I will tell of all your marvellous works.

² I will be glad and rejoice in you.

I will sing praise to your name, O Most High. (9:1-2)

I trust in your loving kindness. My heart rejoices in your salvation.

⁶ I will sing to the LORD, because he has been good to me. (13:5-6)

My soul, you have said to the LORD, "You are my Lord.
Apart from you I have no good thing." (16:2)
